## Welcome To Barangay San Antonio

In the 1950's, what would become the Barangay San Antonio that we know today, was once a 12-hectare barren marshland where 200 residential bungalows housed middle-income families.

The Barrio Charter of 1959 or Republic Act No.2370 was created to officially recognize the community as Barrio San Antonio. It was when the Barangay Charter or Republic Act No.3590 was issued that recognized San Antonio as a barangay of Pasig City.

Today, Barangay San Antonio's territorial jurisdiction encompasses Antonio Village at 12 hectares and certain areas of Ortigas Center at 62 hectares, which totals its land area at 74 hectares. It is also one of Metro Manila's highly ubanized communities which is home to about 20,000 Pasigueños.




is the Barangay Captain of San Antonio, Pasig City.


# Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction & Management Organizational Structure





# Barangay San Antonio Incident Command System Functional Chart

#### **INCIDENT COMMANDER (I.C.)**

Over-all managment and responsibility of the incident or event; establish incident command post (ICP); sets objectives and priorities; stay in charge until relieved by competent superior; may assign personnel for staff and support roles.

#### **SAFETY OFFICER**

Monitors safety conditions and develops measures for assuring safety of all assigned personnel.

#### **INFORMATION OFFICER**

Manages media and public inquiries; coordinates emergency public info and warnings; inform media and conduct briefings.

#### **OPERATION OFFICER**

Develops tactical objectives and organization; direct execution of plans; request releasing of resources.

#### LOGISTICS OFFICER

Identifies service and support needs; provides resources and allother services needed by the incident responders.

#### **LIAISON OFFICER**

Point of contact for other agency representatives involved in incident or event. Helps in coordinating their involvement.

#### **PLANNING OFFICER**

Responsible for collecting, evaluating, disseminating and using the incident plan, and setting up the briefing area.

#### **PLANNING OFFICER**




